Some plays, obviously written with a particular actor or actress in mind, make their immediate impact, but later, like the stick of the rocket, fall to earth when the star is no longer there to sustain them.

"Mrs. Willie" is not one of these. The title-role, it is true, dominates the action, but it is a genuinely humourous part, offering limitless scope to the clever artiste to light up every hilarious, and sometimes tender, scene.

Alan Melville's skill in creating the personality of the Balkan ex-queen did not falter when it came to etching in the other characters. Each adds a part to a wholly likeable play in which we have all enjoyed ourselves.


