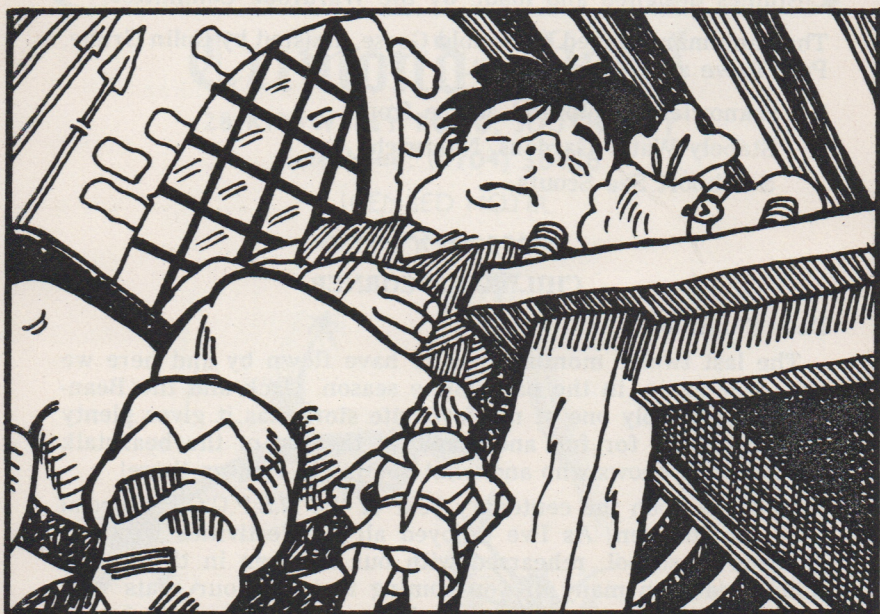
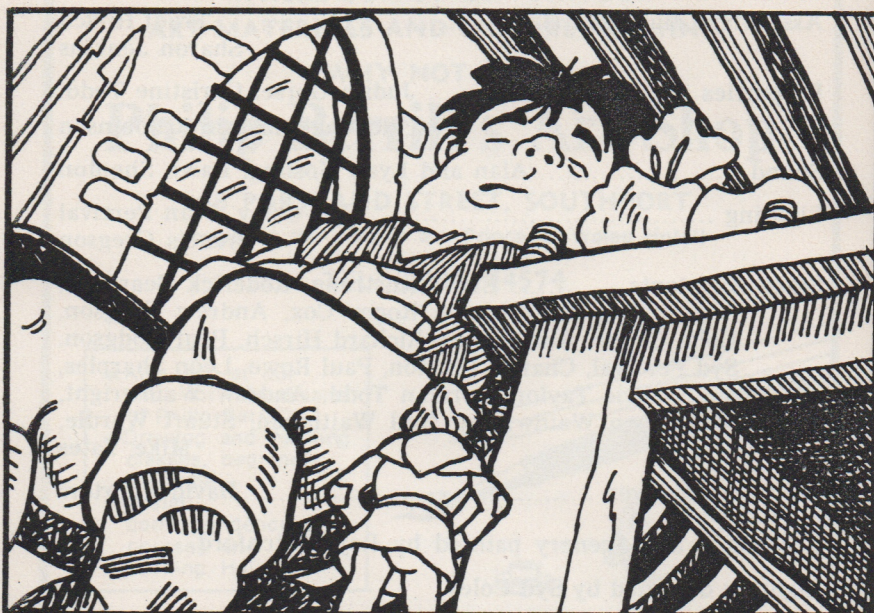
Please thank the people who have arranged your pantomime visit and, whilst we are having fun, remember the children who have not had the joy and love we have shared this Christmas.



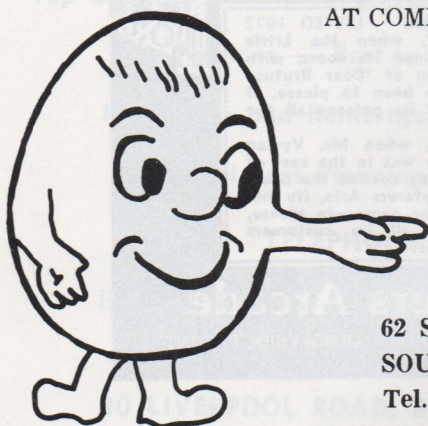
