



EVERYBODY

ROBIN HIRSCH, joined the S.D.C. on her 18th Birthday, more years ago than she cares to remember. Married, (to a long suffering husband) she has two children. Although acting is her first love, she has directed and has worked on various committees. Favourite roles have been 'Opal' (obviously), Meg Bowles in 'The Birthday Party,' Hannah in 'Patrick Pearse Hotel' and Marjorie in 'Dear Octopus.' She has directed 'Picnic' and 'Dame of Sark.'

FRED GOLDSWORTH—only joined the cast in later rehearsals but has soon found his feet.

JANINE GRIME—an acting member since 1958, has appeared in many roles and is no stranger to Benny's prowess as a director. She is delighted to repeat the same role under his direction and join up with Robin once again—a previous shared production was 'Barefoot in the Park.' She has played more recent roles as Lady Hamilton in 'Bequest to the Nation' and Mrs. Hennessy in 'Liver Birds.'

DAVID CHARTERS, feels very much a 'new boy' in this revival of 'Opal.' Along with David Parry and Fred Goldsworth, he is not a member of the original cast. However, he accepted the role of the lean, handsome, Bradford Winter, a man of 'superior intellect' as a challenge.

GORDON WINSLAND, a long standing member of the S.D.C. has been absent from 'The Boards' for the past four years due to business commitments. He appeared with Robin in 'Time for the Cuckoo' and other appearances have been in 'Vivat, Vivat, Regina', 'Royal Hunt of the Sun,' 'Lion in Winter.'

DAVID PARRY has had to settle for the part of Officer Jankie having failed the audition for Mister Tanner. Hoping to leave the New York Police Force and turn Private Eye—may be the chance to play Philip Marlowe one day. Whilst not on stage in this play he listens to tapes of Bruce Springsteen and Randy Newman.

BILL FINN, has been around for many years and is a survivor of the original production playing the same role. Between times he has played a variety of parts the last being that of Canon Pennyfather in 'Murder on the Nile' at the start of this season.



MERRY-GO-ROUND THEATRE WORKSHOPS

MERRY-GO-ROUND (MGR for short) was formed in January and since then several theatre workshop groups have presented productions and Direct Theatre, MGR's professional touring company has been on the road with a production of Canterbury Tales. MGR runs children's creative drama workshops weekly and current membership totals 200 youngsters. The emphasis is very much on 'participation' and group involvement during workshop sessions and all members are invited to take part in at least one production each year.

This summer MGR will be running two theatre schools—the Junior Summer School runs from July 24th until August 2nd, and young people between 7 and 14 are invited to apply. The course will provide a mass of creative activities each day with experienced tutors to lead the various groups, and at the end of the course each group will present a workshop production

for parents and friends.

MGR's Senior Summer Theatre School is designed for 15 to 25 year olds who are interested in drama, dance and music. The course is intensive and rehearsals for the final production take place each day for 4 weeks. Also available to the members this year will be evening classes in tap dancing, stage fighting and other specialist activities. This year's production of 'The Wiz', from Friday, August 30th—Saturday, September 7th at the Little Theatre, promises to be exciting and stretching with a large cast of actors, singers, dancers and musicians.

If anyone is interested in joining the summer company there are still some vacancies left. MGR do not forget the adults and a new course is about to be launched for those interested in creative drama and dance. Again, no experience is necessary and the emphasis is on participation and 'fun'—so mums, if you are interested in spending an hour on a Tuesday afternoon stimu-

lating your creative senses, come and join us.

Senior MGR members will be seen at The Little Theatre from May 29th when they present their first major musical production of 'Grease'—a lively show with lots of singing and dancing, 1950's style. Very soon MGR will be opening their own premises and adding to the list of activities available will be music workshops, art clubs and a writer's circle. 


