





He was then invited to join the BBC, as a writer/producer, on a twelve-month contract. He stayed for 36 years. Among his 2,054 productions are many classic series including Whacko!, Does the Team Think?, Dr. Findlay's Casebook, I'm Sorry - I'll Read That Again, Round the Horne and Just a Minute. As a writer he's supplied material for many of the great comedy stars, among them Arthur Askey, Claude Hulbert, Harry Worth, Morecambe and Wise and the Two Ronnies. His many talents came together when he created, wrote and produced The Men from the Ministry, a show that was to run for fifteen years. Ted's previous stage play, Pardon Me Prime Minister, written with John Graham, enjoyed two national tours and is now a favourite with amateur companies. His hobbies are watching cricket, swimming and loafing in the garden. He lives in Hampstead with his wife, Sue, and daughter, Imogen, born in 1987, whom he regards as his

finest production yet.
