

Director's Notes




Welcome to the SDC and The Little Theatre for tonight's production of "Don't Dress for Dinner" by Marc Camoletti.

Helen has also acted in several recent plays including "Steel Magnolias", with Trudi Hirsch.





Marc Camoletti - Playwright

Marc Camoletti is best known for his smash hit play "Boeing Boeing" which ran in the West End of London at the Apollo Theatre for seven years. "Boeing Boeing" was later made into a film starring Jerry Lewis and Tony Curtis.

Marc Camoletti's world wide acclaim as a playwright spans thirty years. In Paris alone he calculated that 240 actors have appeared in 15 of his plays in 11 different theatres over 33 years. "Don't Dress for Dinner" is also known as "Happy Birthday" in another translation from the original French, premiered in Paris in 1985 and has notched up over 1000 performances.


