It has been a great pleasure for me to work alongside the same production team for the third successive year, and equally pleasurable that so many of our cast from our previous shows are once again on stage.


I hope you enjoy our show. We have some great vocal numbers, some exciting dancing and, of course, lots of fun and laughter.

The Back Stage Crew



any of you will be familiar with the computer phrase - "What you see is what you get". That is definitely not the case at The Little Theatre. Behind the scenes a small army is hard at work throughout each show.

The stage set will change many times as the plot unfolds. All these changes are done by hand, often by moving large and awkward pieces of scenery in near darkness. Some of the changes have to be done very quickly, and can involve up to 15 people doing the right thing at the right time.

Lighting and sound technicians, properties personnel, dressers - all these people are so important in ensuring that the show runs smoothly and that the right ambience is being created.

It is a highly complex organisation behind the scenes, and, once the show moves from the rehearsal rooms and takes to the stage, the whole operation is under the control of one person, the Stage Manager.

For the past few weeks, the backstage crew have been busy building and creating the sets alongside the theatre's scenery artist, Bob Jessamine, and under the overall guidance of Arnold Gorse, who once again has staged this year's spectacular show.

But of course, the backstage crew are by no means the only 'invisible' SDC members helping to bring you the show today, and every single person involved in our pantomime trusts that you will have an enjoyable time, and hopes that you will visit 'The Little' on many future occasions.


