Director's Notes



Robin Hawdon was born in Newcastle-on-Tyne and trained as an actor at RADA. His acting career spanned over twenty years and included appearances in the West End with such diverse stars as Ralph Richardson, Sheila Hancock and Kenneth Williams.

In 1982 he gave up his acting career for a while to concentrate on writing and directing. Over the years he has had plays performed at the Hampstead Theatre, the Salzburg, King's Lynn and Edinburgh Festivals and on various national and foreign tours. One of Robin's best known plays "The Mating Game" ran for eighteen months at the Apollo Theatre, London. Other plays such as "The Hero," Love Match" and "Birthday Suite" have been produced on tour in the provinces and abroad.

Hawdon's first novel "A Rustle In The Grass" was published in 1985 and sold over sixty thousand copies. From 1983 - 1986 he was Theatre Director at The Theatre Royal, Bath.




Helen Pickavance

Saturday, January 19, 1974

Night the Beatles played the Little Theatre and no-one screamed

The greatest secret the Little Theatre has ever kept within its wall in recent years must be the fact that the Beatles once were recorded on its stage.

It happened on the evening that the four famous lads from Liverpool were playing live on stage at the Odeon, Lord Street, an evening which was being televised for a late night Sunday show.

The hysterical screaming and shouting of the thousands of young fans who had packed into the cinema to see the group was so loud that an acceptable sound recording of the show just could not be taken.

So it was secretly arranged that the group should be smuggled into the Little Theatre beforehand so that a good sound recording could be taken to dub onto the film being taken later at the live show.

This was one of the only times that professionals have actually used the Little Theatre, apart from the war years when Sheffield Rep. used it.

In fact it is true to say that the Little Theatre is an amateur theatrical paradise. It is cosy, intimate and above all friendly, even to a new-comer.

It would be difficult to go to the Little Theatre and find it empty. If there isn't a full scale rehearsal going on for one or other of the seasons' there will plays. someone adjusting lighting sequences, experimenting with sound effects, sizing up sets and hunting for props, sorting out costumes and madly sewing, stocktaking in the bar, checking box office receipts, simply cleaning up. But never, never empty.

Today the Theatre is still never ever empty, some things will never change.

But how many of you knew about the Beatles.

Watch this space for many more secrets from the SDC's history.

The Stage Manager

Near the top of the back stage food chain you will find the stage manager (known as the SM), they are generally to be found in a semi-recumbent pose with a drink in one hand and another drink in the other.

Seriously the SM not only has to deliver explosive effects, have the ability to control the weather but also keep all the actors (a lower form of life) under control once the Director has handed the play over for performance.

From constructing sets to ensuring that all technical departments function as one, the SM makes sure that only the most professional staging is seen at the Little Theatre.




